I write with great urgency to inform you that 2 (two) Members of Parliament of Nationalist namely Mr. Praful Patel and Mr. Sunil Tatkare, have acted in violation of our Constitution, Rules of our Party and have also indulged in anti-party activities by facilitating and spearheading swearing of oath of 9 (nine) MLAs as Cabinet Ministers of Government of Maharashtra at 2:30 pm at Rajbhawan, Malabar Hills, Mumbai. They have further openly made statements to this effect before the media and have acted in complete violation of Party's direction and principles. You may further be informed that this decision of the 2 (two) Members of Parliament to support the 9 (nine) MLAs has been taken without the permission of the Party President and without taking all members into confidence.

The fact these defections were done in such secretive manner, without the knowledge or consent of the Party President, amount to desertion of the party which in turn invites disqualification. With this, it has become abundantly clear that the said Members of Parliament no longer share the aims and ideology of the NCP.

They have acted in direct contravention of the Party Constitution and Rules to further their own personal ambitions. Their actions are also a direct betrayal of the mandate given by the electorate and Party.

I therefore request you to take immediate steps against them including filing of disqualification petitions under the 10<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution of India before the Competent Authority.

Respected Sir/Ma'am

It is brought to your information that basis letter notice received by Shri Anil Deshmukh, MLA, Vidhan Sabha, the MLAs mentioned below have indulged in anti-party activities on 2 July 2023 in clear and absolute violation of Article 32 of the Constitution of the Nationalist Congress Party and as per the Rules framed under Article 21(vi)(a) of the said Constitution.

Accordingly, the State Discipline Committee passed a resolution dated 2 July 2023 recorded the factum of disqualification of the said 9 (nine) MLAs from the party due to their indulgence in anti-party activities.

It is recorded that the fact these defections were done in such a secretive manner, without the knowledge or consent of the Party President, amounts to desertion of the party which in turn invites disqualification.

The Party has therefore initiated on 2 July 2023 itself, appropriate proceedings for formal disqualification of these MLAs from the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly under the 10<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution of India.

In light of the same, the State Discipline Committee after consultation with NCP President Shri Sharad Pawar, passed the said resolution. Attached herewith is a copy of the Resolution passed by the State Discipline Committee on 2 July 2023.

You are required to acknowledge the same and refrain from misrepresenting before any forum that you have any association with the NCP Party. Any such act of misrepresentation would be absolutely unlawful and illegal.

It has been brought to the notice of the Central Discipline Committee vide letter dated 2 July 2023 by Anil Deshmukh, MLA, Maharashtra Vidhan Sabha, that 9 MLAs of the NCP party have indulged in anti-party activities in clear and absolute violate of Article 32 of the Party Constitution.

These actions of the 9 MLAs call for immediate disqualification as not only are such defections ipso facto seriously damaging to the party but also that if allowed to continue as members, there is a very real likelihood that they will continue to try and undermine the interests of the party.

The fact that these defections were done in such a secretive manner, without the knowledge or consent of the Party President, amounts to desertion of the party which in turn invites disqualification.

We take cognisance of the same and direct appropriate steps may be taken in accordance with the Party Constitution and rules as also the tenth schedule of the Constitution of India. As per the procedure, Shri Sharad Pawar, Party President has been informed and consulted for the same.
